## Re: Area Green Space Plans

I am writing to inform you that the the public consultation process on draft copies of the Council's Area Green Space Plans, the first stage in implementing its Parks and Green Space Strategy, will now take place in January 2010 instead of Autumn 2009 as originally intended. This will enable us to respond to the changing timetable of the Bristol Development Framework, in particular the Site Allocations Development Plan Document, and ensure that open space spatial planning and investment work continues to be aligned with wider spatial planning proposals for housing, employment, leisure etc. It will also of course allow us more time to develop the content of each Area Green Space Plan and consider the ideas and proposals put forward by communities and others across the city.

The work to involve community representatives and other stakeholders in helping develop proposals for each Plan is now being picked up again after a six-week pause in the lead up to the elections. The aim is to complete these by the end of July at the latest. Invitations to meetings to gather ideas and opinions on specific parks and open spaces are being sent out now.
