

Proposals for parks, green spaces and play spaces in the Knowle West area



Definitions:

Formal green space - Ornamental gardens with planting schemes and statues, or designed squares or landscapes, .

Informal green space - Informal in layout or character, with a low level of landscaping and few or no additional facilities.

Natural green space - Important refuges for wildlife and places where we can experience and enjoy contact with the natural world.

Children's play space - Provision of equipment in designated play spaces.

Young persons space - diverse, exciting and challenging spaces for young people, including equipment, wheels parks and shelters.

MUGA - This is a 'multi-use games area' which will allow children and teenagers to play a range of sports (e.g. hockey, football, basketball and netball) on the same pitch.
