In Redcatch Road, Knowle in South Bristol just 1 minute from A37 Wells Road about 5 minutes from Temple Meads Rail Station.

No 2, 92 & 376 buses go to Wells Road and No 511 to Redcatch Road outside the centre from Brislington and Bedminster.
