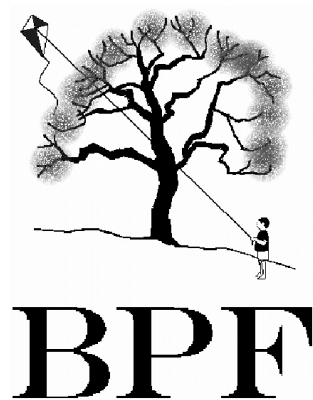

Street Tree/fruit tree Planting	Mark	5 Nov 2014 14:05	Each Neighbourhood partnership will be invited to ask for applications from interested parties within their neighbourhood partnership to apply for some or all the funding during the first 2 quarters of 2015. The 14 Partnerships will then confirm with the Bristol Parks Forum By August 2015 the intended project/s. Each partnership will have the opportunity to submit an application for £1785.71 for the funding of either street tree replacement or fruit tree	£25,000
Recycling in parks	Mark	5 Nov 14 14:09	This project has been raised many times by parks group members as an ambition to have recycling in parks across Bristol. The amount of funding applied for will not enable each park to have recycling bins but will enable BCC to monitor and assess the feasibility or glass/plastic recycling across the city. The intention is to install 2 standard size street bins at the entrance to approximately 10 parks across the city. (more should costs allow)	£30,000

This application for funding is to enable our voluntary and community sector partners (listed above) to participate and to share their specific skills and expertise with parks group volunteers.	£50,000

Digital Project to promote Bristol's Parks and Green Spaces	Sam	5 Nov 14 14:44	This application is for funding to create an app (and associated web 'home' page) for visitors to Bristol, as well as for current residents which will enable them to identify their nearest publicly accessible park and/or green space, to see which facilities are available in them (where the nearest adventure play for young people is, for example or which parks have play areas and public toilet facilities for those with young children).	£36,000
Urban Greenway in Southmead	Sam	5 Nov 14 15:49	Our intention is to facilitate an action-research project led by the local community (including residents of all ages and from a wide range of backgrounds and interest groups) to design and deliver green change in Southmead by working together to create an Urban Greenway on Doncaster Road (between Southmead Road/Hospital and the nearest green space – Badocks Woods open space).	£50,000
