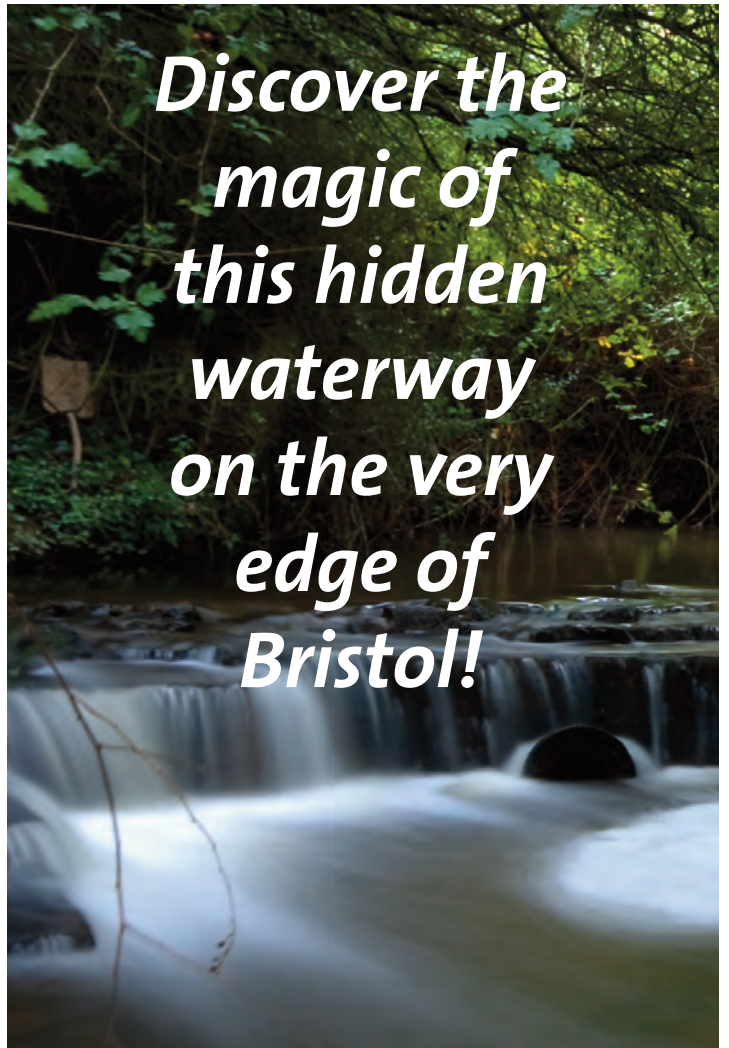
The Colliter's Brook Trek

Sunday 24th May 2009 10am – lunchtime

Come and explore Colliter's with us! We will follow the brook upstream as it winds its way beneath Greville Smyth Park, past Bristol City Football Ground, through Ashton Vale and onwards and upwards towards Bedminster Down. We'll finish at the waterfall in Hanging Hill Wood with a picnic.



- Meet at 10am in the CREATE Centre car park (Smeaton Rd)
- The walk is about 2 miles each way and is mostly flat apart from the final slopes in Hanging Hill Wood. There are 2 stiles and it can be muddy and rough underfoot.
- There will be short talks of interest along the way.
- Bring water to drink, and your own picnic to enjoy at the end.
- Wear comfortable shoes and clothing suitable for the weather. There are no public toilets close to the route.
- Walk back with us to the CREATE Centre, or catch a bus on the A38.
