Development/Improvement Plans	Management Plans
<p>Sets out a vision and aspiration for the park</p> <p>Focus in on what is there – what is missing – what is required and why.</p> <p>Assumes a need for improvement which is likely to require capital investment</p> <p>Includes a master plan for the park</p> <p>Series of prioritised costed interventions</p> <p>The master plan and interventions are subject to public consultation - This consultation directs the development of the masterplan , the proposed improvements and the priorities</p> <p>Usually includes a phased strategy for improvement based on prioritisation</p> <p>Identifies possible funding for investment</p>	<p>Starts from an agreed vision of the park and aims of the plan</p> <p>Identifies policy basis for the plan</p> <p>Identifies the communities of interest</p> <p>Sets out current management regime, resources and recent investment</p> <p>Identifies issues, how these are currently being addressed</p> <p>Identifies areas of significance, and proposals for exploring, retaining or exposing these to a wider public.</p> <p>Identifies improvements (potential new capital development but mainly incremental investment of non capital resources to improve, renew, maintain the site for users)</p> <p>May include developmental aspirations, but needs to include a route to delivery.</p> <p>Include management and maintenance roles and responsibilities.</p> <p>Includes a 5-year action plan, reviewed annually.</p>
