### Context

- This is our project to shape and make successful
- Bristol Parks Forum, Bristol Council, and LUC secured funding from the UK 'Rethinking Parks' Programme (Nesta and Heritage Lottery Fund)
  - "£1 million fund to find new business models that will sustain the UK's public parks in the face of significant funding cuts."
- One of 11 projects to have received funding just under £100,000 (from 209 Expressions of Interest).
- ParkWork is a 15 month practical pilot of costs and benefits of involving volunteers and placement workers in the management of parks and public open space in Bristol



## Project Objectives

- To Enhance Resources available for management of Bristol's parks and green spaces.
- To Support Quality Parks, towards meeting community park groups aspirations and implementing management plans.
- To Deliver Social Benefits, providing marginalised communities with new skills and training.

- Tools, PPE, comfort wagon, minibus hire being procured




## Current position (2/2)
