Guidelines for choosing a park for a Tree Plan

DRAFT Guidelines for Park Groups, the Tree Forum, the Parks Forum, Environmental subgroups and Neighbourhood Partnerships for choosing a park for a Tree Plan

We can produce 1 Tree Plan per Neighbourhood Partnership area per year

It is up to the Neighbourhood Partnership to chose which park the Tree Plan is produced for in their Neighbourhood Partnership area

The Neighbourhood Partnership may delegate this decision to their Envrionmental sub-groups for the NP to ratify

We will be asking the Neighbourhood Partnerships to make or ratify this decision at their March and April meetings

We have produced some broad guidelines to help select parks for which to produce a Tree Plan, see below

Using these guidelines we have put together a list of parks in each Neighbourhood Partnership which we could produce a Tree Plan for (attached)

We welcome suggestions from NPs, Parks Groups other interested groups to add parks to this list, using following the guildelines to support these suggestions

We will be giving this list of proposed parks to the Environmental subgroups and Neighbourhood Partnerships to help them make their decision

The Council will not influence or overturn the decision made by the Neighbourhood Partnership, as long as they have followed the guidelines and the decision does not conflict with other Council decisions or projects

- 1 Demand have there been lots of requests for more trees in the park?
 - have there been lots of trees lost from in the park which have not been replaced?
 - is there a keen Friends group that would like a long-term plan for the trees in their park? NB this will not include tree management
 - is there a need for Tree Plan that is agreed by the Council and the local residents or a Park Group focussing on tree replacement?

- are there lots of locations in which trees could be planted? Ideally a minimum of 20 planting locations, though in some NPs this will not be
