TreeBristol - Streets (responsible officer - Neil Gazzard)

This is a three year programme to plant trees in grass verges along streets targeting wards with higher social deprivation and lower canopy cover. We will be planting over 350 trees by March.

Other tree planting and news

We will be replacing around 150 Highways trees that were removed in the past, on an "oldest first" basis. We are also planting 10 sponsored street trees. We will be planting over 260 trees on Housing sites across the city.

Josie and Neil are unfortunately leaving the Council at the end of February. They have done some great works and we are making arrangements to cover their roles to the end of this season and into the future.

NB A large tree on planting is a 16-18cm (girth) tree in grass with double stake and double cage. A small tree on planting is a 40-60cm whip with stake, tubex protection and single cage. The cost of planting into tarmac is higher to cover the construction of an engineered tree pit.
