### How do we align NPs & Parks Groups?

- BCC needs an overview of what's happening in each area.
- Impossible for members of the Park group to attend all the meetings happening & influence decisions.
- All NPs work in completely different ways huge problems & make it difficult for vols to engage
- What is the role of B.P.F in this process?
- What will happen to green spaces without active groups?
- Need to have a clear means of making decisions & who is able to part
  In that process & means of resolving conflict.
- Be clear about who will enforce decisions.
- Make sure environment subgroups are functioning well in each NP;
  Should be attended by a Bcc officer; make sure local parks groups are invited to attend & realise importance of attending.

#### **Priorities**

- Maintain what we have.
- Are green flag parks the priority, if so , can other parks become G.F parks/
- Recognise different needs of Nature Reserves & have a management plan.
- Need officers with horticultural & arborial & wildlife expertise.
- Set up an expert's panel to advice on nature conservation (eg. BNAC).
- Need management plans that are concise & easy to draw up by VDLS.

## **Cost implications of change**

- How do we decide.
- Eg; bins instead of grass cutting.

Can we identify more important spaces?

- Heritage Estates.
- Nature Reserves
- Formal Parks.
- Open Spaces.
- Destination Parks.

Worry that these will drain resources from other parks spaces at the detriment to.

Minimum standard for all spaces.
