Friends of St. Anne's Park is for anyone and everyone who shares an interest in the park in St. Anne's, Bristol BS4. Achievements so far include getting a new bin installed in the car park, a new community noticeboard, a book swap and the beginnings of a small community garden.

St Anne's Park (sometimes known locally as Langton Park) comprises an informal football pitch, hardcourt football pitch, a basketball/tennis court, a children's playground, a bowls club plus lots of open space. There are many species of trees and animal life including foxes, owls, bats and woodpeckers. The park has vehicle access from Newbridge Road leading to a small free carpark. There are pedestrian access points from Langton Road and Langton Court Road.

The Friends of St Anne's Park aim to ensure that St Anne's Park is maintained as a public park of benefit to both wildlife and people. We will;

- Liaise with Bristol City Council to ensure a high level of care for St Anne's Park and to have a say in how the site is managed
- Provide a friendly and welcoming community focus for people interested in St Anne's Park
- Contribute to making St Anne's Park a safe and inviting place to visit
- Work to improve understanding and increase respect of St Anne's Park by the local community
- Contribute to the management of St Anne's Park, including the creation and protection of wildlife habitats
- Research and collect information relevant to St Anne's Park, for example on the wildlife and history of the site
- Work with Bristol City Council and other bodies to ensure that the effects on St Anne's Park are considered in any plans or developments for surrounding areas.
