Consultation on Budget 2024-25 November 2023 – response from Bristol Parks Forum Committee.

We work with Bristol City Council to ensure our spaces are well looked after and to help local groups to enhance their green space. We are writing in to ask for two things:

- Reassurance that whatever is the result of further consideration of the funding and pressures on the Council's budgets, that the Parks and Green Spaces related budget will not be reduced in actual or comparative terms.
- Early warning of any changes to the parks department budgets that may occur which affect parks and green spaces. We would also welcome the chance to comment on them should they occur.

You will be familiar with the many benefits that our parks and green spaces provide to the City, its residents and its wildlife.

It is critical that those are maintained and enhanced so that those benefits continue and are available to all residents.

We have copied this to Cllr Ellie King, Cabinet Member for Public Health and Communities; and Jon James, Head of the Natural and Marine Environment in the City Council.
